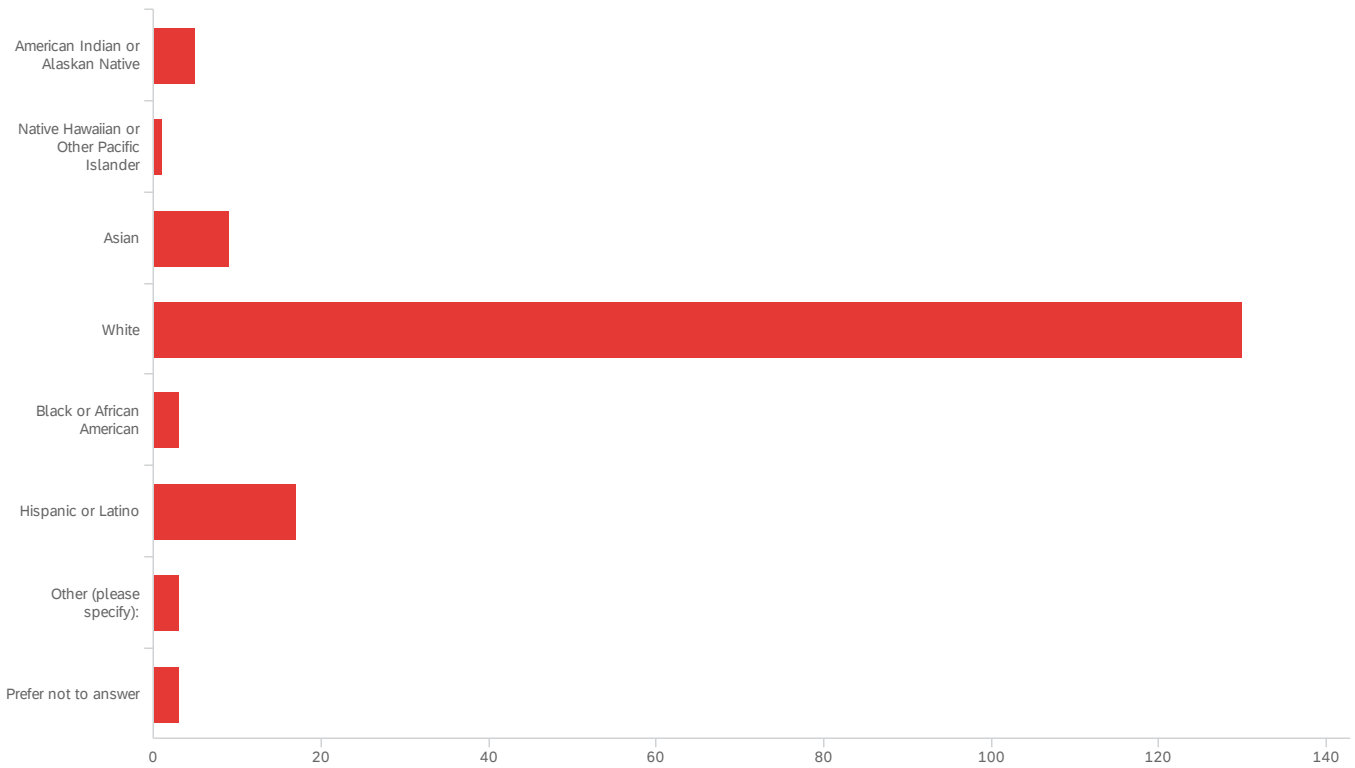

Q15 - How important was CSU's sustainability reputation in your decision to attend CSU?

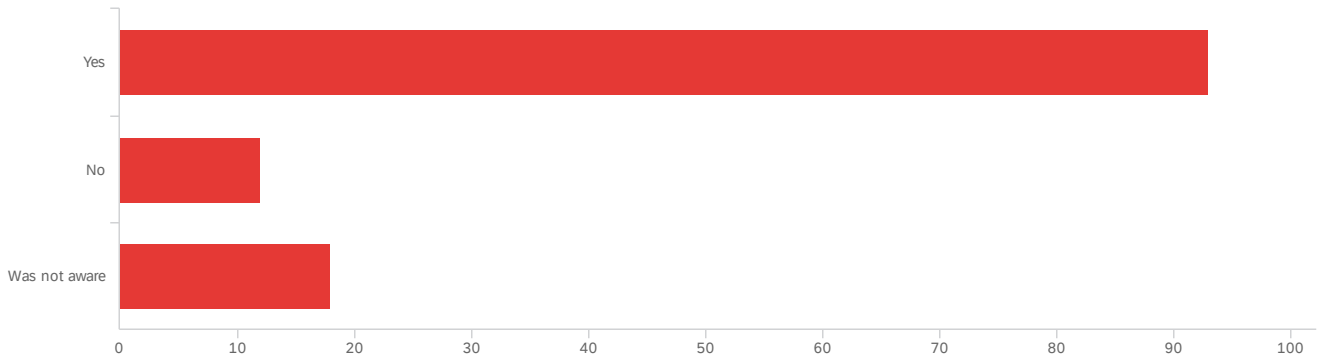

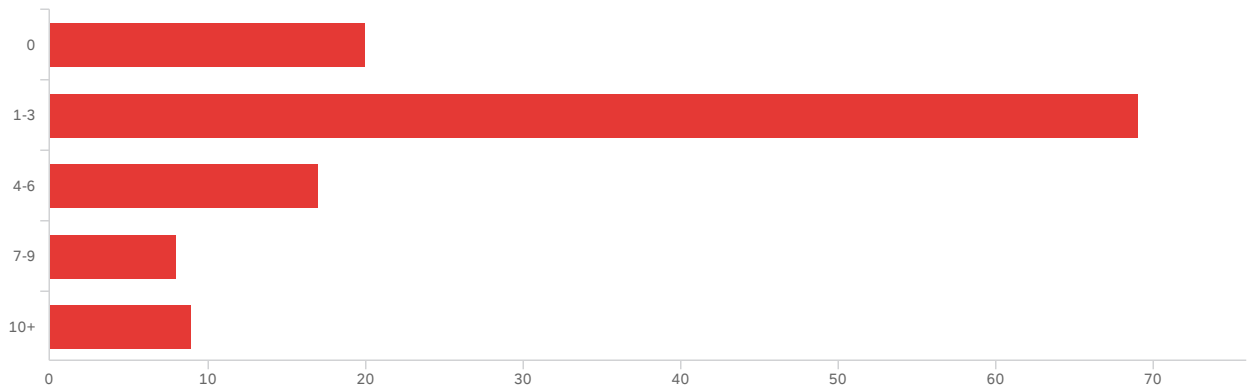

Q17 - In your courses at CSU, how many have addressed sustainability in some way?

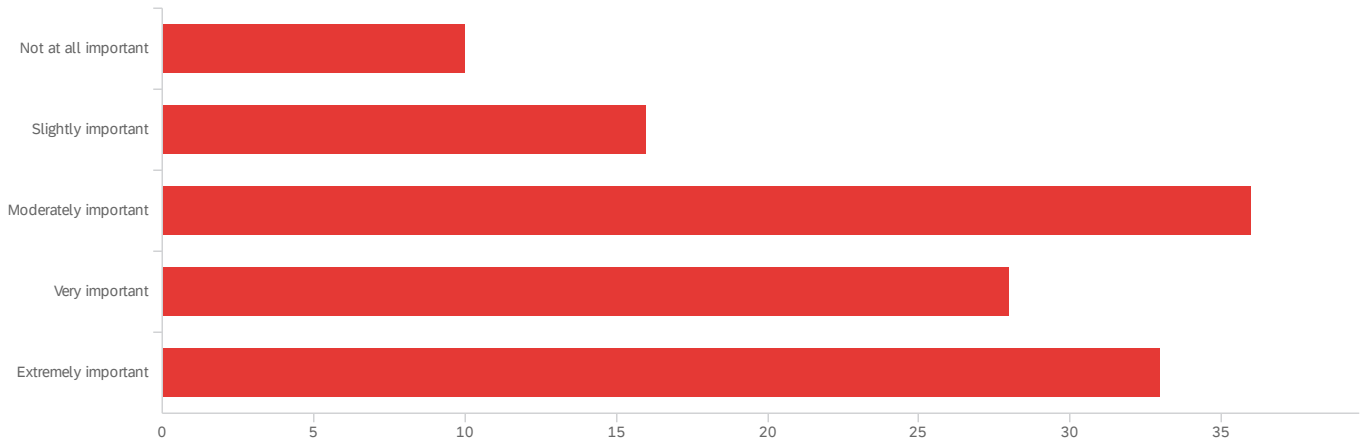

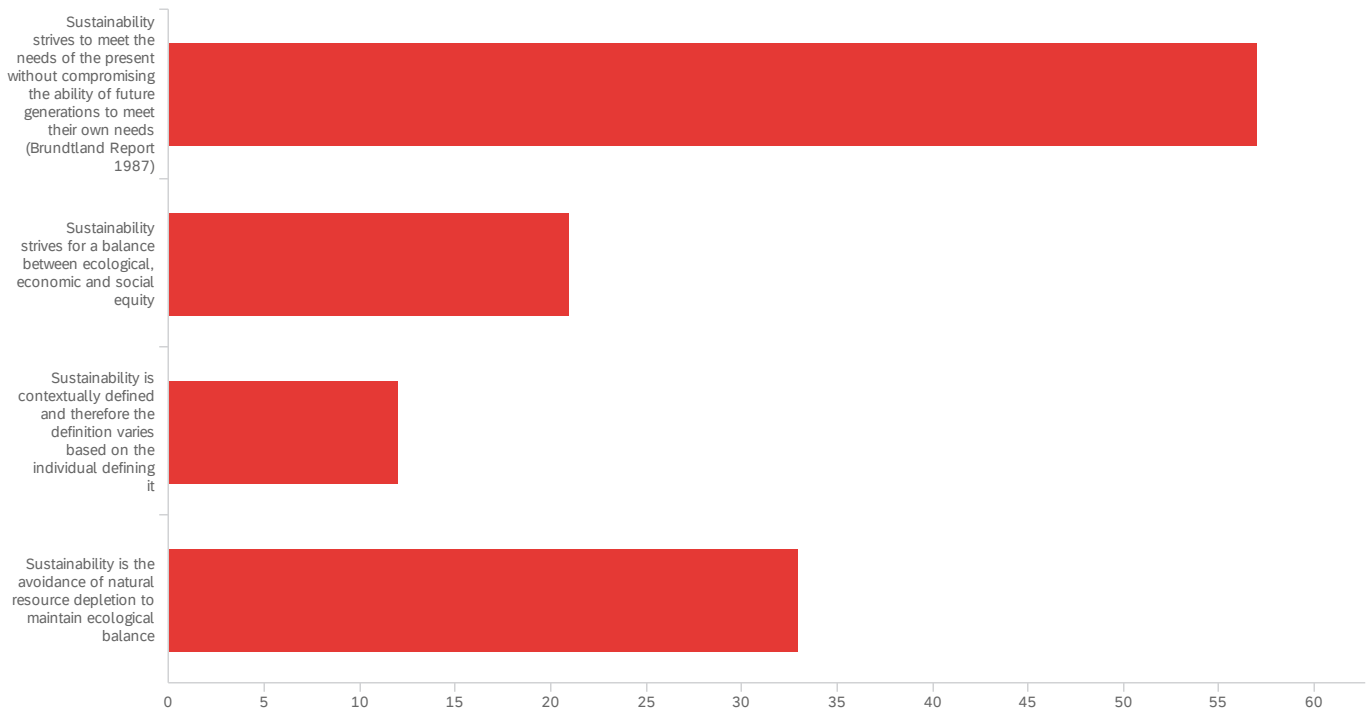
